

Maddy Gordon debuts for Silver Ferns

Congratulations to Maddy Gordon, who made her international debut for the Silver Ferns last week against the Australian Diamonds during the Constellation Cup netball series. Maddy was named in the Silver Ferns squad last August, and joined fellow Albertian Maia Wilson in the national squad.

The call-up followed Maddy being named the MVP in the final as her Central Pulse team won the ANZ Premiership title over the Tactix last year.

Maddy was MAGS' Victrix Ludorum in 2017, having excelled in a number of sports at MAGS, including netball.

The Silver Ferns played a three-test series against England in Hamilton in October and November but Maddy did not get on court.

She finally got some game time against the Diamonds in the Silver Ferns' 3-1 series win.
